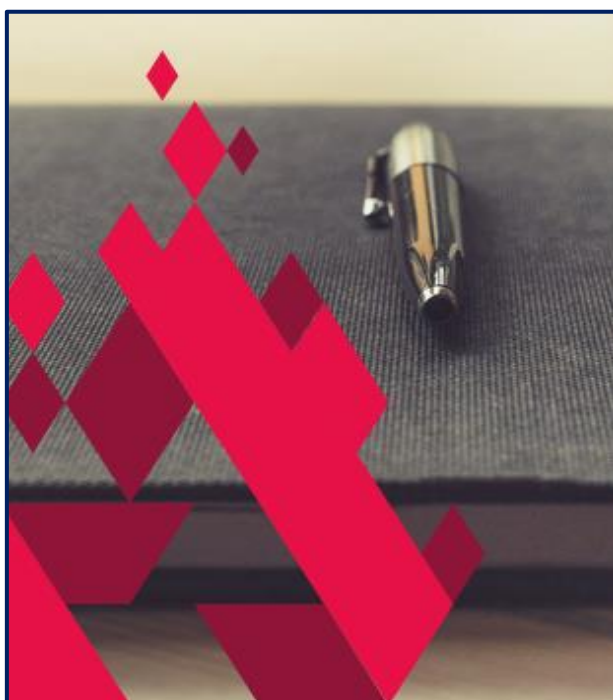
A WORD FROM THE EDITOR

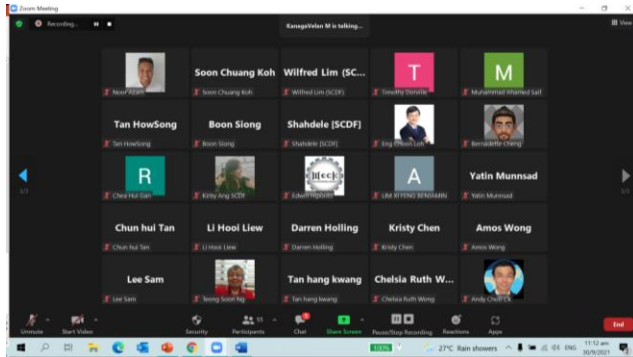
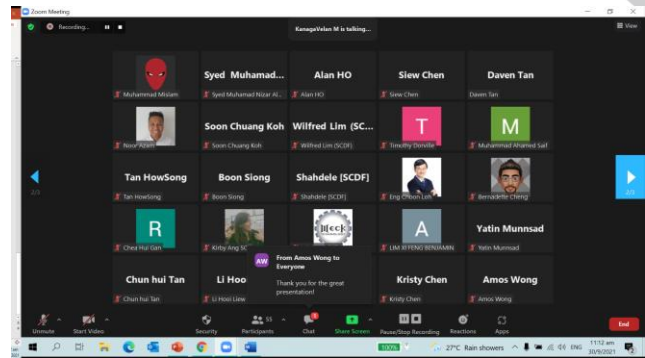
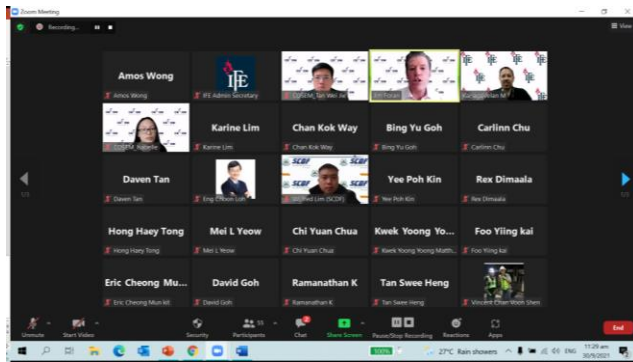

Target Audience

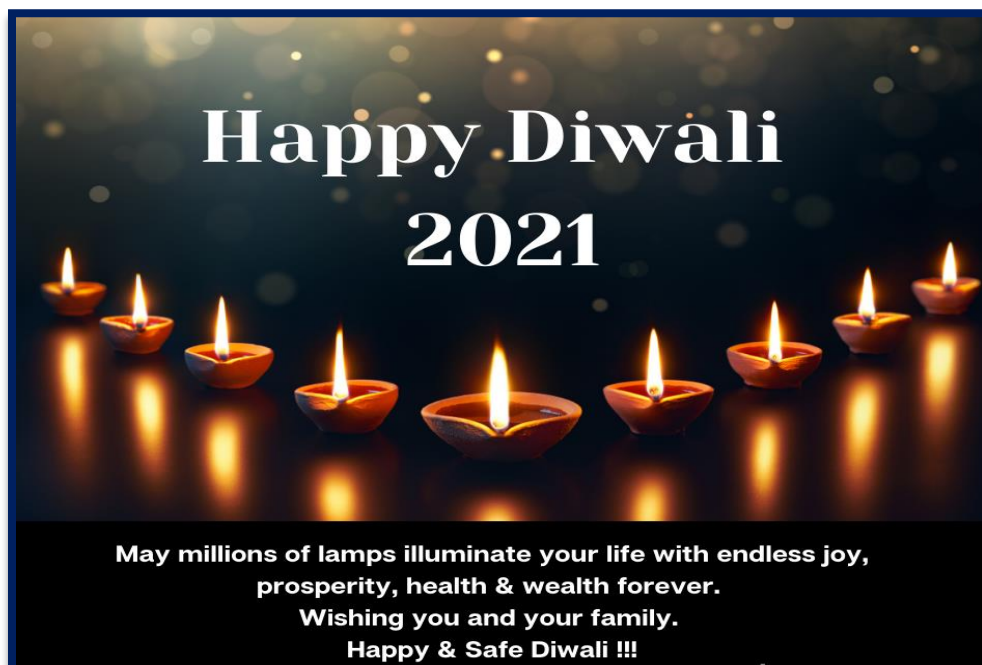
Personnel involved in operating and maintaining protection systems in all types of buildings.
