
Fire Detection Seminar with Professor Daniel Nilsson

The sharing covered the signatures generated by different types of fires which are essential for fire detector selection, exploration of alternative detection techniques (e.g., flame detectors, gas detectors, aspirating detectors, fiber-optic line heat detectors, multiple source detectors, etc.).

IFES Fire Safety Update Webinar


3rd November 2022 from 12:30pm to 6pm

ONLINE WEBINAR

As part of IFES continuing professional development efforts for the wider fire safety community and industry, IFES organized a webinar provide attendees a better understanding to fire regulations and best practices.

The webinar addressed FSM responsibilities and responses with regards to DECAM, with updates on the latest SS546:2022 – Emergency Voice Communications in Buildings and SS578: Amendment 1 – Use and Maintenance of Portable Extinguishers.

Invited speakers elaborated on the latest updates to the Code of Practice for Fire Precautions in Buildings 2018 (Batch 11) and electric vehicle charging in buildings. Additionally, IFES representatives presented on the salient updates of Code of Practice for Fire Precautions in Rapid Transit System from 2017 to 2022.
